

She is the author of Ma Hezhi and the Illustration of the Book of Odes, Mirror of Morality: Chinese Narrative Illustration and Confucian Ideology, and many articles on Chinese painting, woodblock printing, narrative illustration, and pictorial biography.

He is the author of Power of Place: The Religious Landscape of the Southern Sacred Peak [Nanyue 南嶽] in Medieval China (Harvard, 2009), and many influential articles on Buddhism, Daoism, and Chan Buddhism in relation to material and bodily practices.
